GRANT NEWS

The Friends have again been successful in obtaining two grants from the Friends of Parks Small Grants Program 2023/24. We have secured funding of: -

- \$5,000.00 for the production of plant labels for the Balcanoona revegetation plantings, and
- \$4,800.00 for partial fuel reimbursement for vehicle providers for our park visits this year.

Call for a volunteer to lead our Plants Labels Project

Plant-identification labels for trees and shrubs planted by the Friends of V-GRNP for the Re-vegetation project at Balcanoona Headquarters.

We now call for Expressions of Interest from our members to take charge of the production of plant labels. This would involve:


- 1. Finalising the list of Common/Adnyamathanha/Scientific names that would be on the labels (we have a list of almost final names).
- 2. Finalising the list of plants at Balcanoona for which labels are required and the number of each variety. (This could be done by the members attending Balcanoona in April with assistance of the Rangers).
- 3. Liaising with a commercial firm that would produce the labels (we have a suggested supplier in Pt Augusta).
- 4. Purchasing aluminium rod and making of stakes, and a person or people to physically attach the labels onto stakes as required.
- 5. Locating the labels in the ground adjacent to the appropriate plants.
- 6. Reporting to the Committee on progress with the grant funds expenditure.
