
## Vulkathunha-Gammon Ranges Geology

The approximate area to be covered is displayed below.




Photographs of interesting geology, such as the folding sediments in the image below will be included.



## ASTER what does it show?

The Advanced Spaceborne Thermal Emission and Reflection Radiometer (ASTER) image of the region from a satellite, shows the regional geology as seen via the reflected/emitted "light" in 14 different wavelengths of the electromagnetic spectrum.
